Teaching

As a senior lecturer, teaching is a regular activity which I enjoy immensely. I organise and convene the Bolton Hip Arthroplasty Course, which is an annual course aimed at teaching junior doctors the art of hip replacement surgery. My other teaching activities include

- Post graduate MSc course Salford University
- FY2 teaching programme Royal Bolton Hospital

- Regional StR teaching programme
- Various FRCS (Tr&Orth) viva preparation courses
- Founder of Registrars Forum for North West trainees

I am clinical supervisor and AES to a StR trainee at present and perform regular assessments of other junior doctors in the department. Recently I was nominated as Trainer of the Year for the North West Deanery.

Management Skills

Clinical Governance Lead Clinician - responsible for all governance issues arising within the orthopaedic department.

Hip Fracture Lead Clinician - responsibility for overseeing the performance of the department with respect to hip fractures. Instrumental in devising a new hip fracture pathway and streamlining the service to encompass enhanced recovery principles. Responsibility to deliver the Best Practice Tariff criteria, therefore ensuring best practice and high quality service delivery for patients. I have improved our performance significantly since taking on this role, allowing Bolton to be directly comparable to the best performing hospitals in the country. I have presented our achievements to the Board and at national meetings.

Enhanced Recovery Steering Committee group - to develop Enhanced Recovery pathways further for trauma and elective patients to improve the quality of our service as well as the patient experience.

Commissioning Group - represented the Orthopaedic department and liaised with the Commissioning Group regarding the referral pathway for lower limb elective patients from primary to secondary care. Involved producing a series of guidelines for GPs in an attempt to streamline the referral pathway and reduce the number of inappropriate referrals to the hospital.

Involved in regular mortality meetings for hip fracture patients and risk management meetings.
