Teaching

As a senior lecturer, teaching is a regular activity which I enjoy immensely. I organise and convene the Bolton Hip Arthroplasty Course, which is an annual course aimed at teaching junior doctors the art of hip replacement surgery. My other teaching activities include

Management Skills

Clinical Governance Lead Clinician - responsible for all governance issues arising within the orthopaedic department.

Hip Fracture Lead Clinician - responsibility for overseeing the performance of the department with respect to hip fractures. Instrumental in devising a new hip fracture pathway and streamlining the service to encompass enhanced recovery principles.
